## Scallop Stitch Tips

Note: I'm showing the 3-stitch scallop used in the cowl, but I'm working it on the fingerless mittens which uses a 2-stitch version. I remembered that I needed photos for the tutorial once I was already done the cowl.

So what I'm showing doesn't line up with the scallop stitches worked below, But that doesn't matter one jot. The tips still work.





You can slip the stitches as one group or one at a time, whatever works best for you. (Remember to slip them purlwise.)

Once you've slipped them, spread them out on the right needle.



You want the space between the purl stitches that anchor the scallops on either side to be at least as big or a bit bigger than the space the stitches would normally take.
