
Gnoddy Knitalong

Each week will kick off with a Zoom with tutorial videos and a chance to ask questions before you tackle the week's portion of Gnoddy.

The Zooms will open at noon, Central Daylight Time. Meetings will be recorded and posted within 24 hours. Zoom links and the recordings will be posted on the knitalong page

Week 1 - May 11-17: The Hat and Sweater Yoke

Zoom meetup on May 11 will cover tips for the hat earflaps and brim, making and attaching the bobble, picking up sts, and the sweater yoke (up to and including Round 14).

Week 2 - May 18-24: The Sweater, Sleeves, and Hands

Zoom meetup on May 18 will cover picking up and starting the sleeves, finishing the body, and adding the hands.

Week 3 - May 26-31: Finishing the Body, Knitting the Nose and Beard, and Assembly

Zoom meetup on May 26 will cover picking up sts for the body, making the nose and beard, and assembling Gnoddy.

The form to enter your Gnoddy in the knitalong prize draw will open on May 25 and close May 31 so that prizes can be announced at the June 1 Zoom. You'll find the entry form link on the knitalong page, in the Ravelry thread, and in my Instagram profile.

Week 4 - June 1: Celebrations and Show & Tell

This week's Zoom is a big ol' party! Handing out prizes, showing off your Gnoddy, and celebrating.

Rules

- You must start and finish your Gnoddy in the month of May to be eligible for prizes.
- You may use any yarn you wish.
- You may enter more than once if you make more than one Gnoddy.
- You may modify Gnoddy if I can tell you started with her pattern.
- To enter, you will fill out a Google Form to link to either your Ravelry project page or your Instagram post. Only one entry per finished gnome. The form will open on May 25 and close May 31 so that prizes can be announced at the June 1 Zoom. You'll find the entry form link here, in the Ravelry thread, in my Instagram profile, and more.
